### **ANNUAL REPORT 2021**

The name of this corporation is Ananda College Old Boys Association of West Coat, USA. The name of the corporation may be abbreviated ACOBA – West Coast.

#### **PURPOSES**

This corporation has been formed for charitable purposes, to

- Support primarily the educational goals of Ananda College, Colombo, Sri Lanka ("College") and, if funds permit, other educational projects in Sri Lanka and USA.
- Work with Ananda College Old Boys Association in Sri Lanka and the Ananda College administration to determine educational projects of Ananda College including, but not limited to, scholarships, books, educational materials and supplies, and educational facilities the corporation can assist in.
- Facilitate fellowship among Anandians (former students and teachers of Ananda College)
  living outside Sri Lanka and in particular in the west coast of USA as the unity and cohesion
  among them would in turn facilitate the corporation's main objective of assisting
  educational needs of the College.

In addition, this corporation is formed for the purposes of performing all things incidental to, or appropriate in, the achievement of the foregoing specific and primary purposes. However, the corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of its primary charitable purposes. This corporation shall hold and may exercise all such powers as

may be conferred upon a nonprofit corporation by the laws of the State of California and as may be necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of the corporation. In no event shall the corporation engage in activities which are not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

# Webinar on Covid 19- Vaccines, complications, and mental health -February 21st

Continuing the pioneering Covid-19 seminars in 2020, another Zoom Seminar was held on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2021, under the subject heading of 'Covid-19 Vaccines, Complications and Mental Health'.

President Rakshita's objective for this meeting was to boost confidence of the public on getting vaccinated in a timely manner and its preventive benefits. The seminar was moderated by Dr. Lasika Seneviratne and was spearheaded by our own Infectious Diseases' Consultant Dr. Deepthi Jayasekera and was well supported by Professor of Psychiatry Dr. Kapila Marambage.

The opening remarks were provided by Ambassador Ravinatha Ariyasinghe. The seminar was a huge success with almost 300 people joining the meeting.

## Dr. Sri Welaratne Scholarship Program

The ACOBAWC annual scholarship at Ananda College is funded by the interest from a fixed deposit in Peoples Bank of Sri Lanka.

The 85 group of OBA is locally managing the scholarship program together with ACOBA-WC. No payments were made for 2021 due to the disruption of the academic activities that resulted due to Covid- 19.

## Funding for the Washroom Project-Ananda Elementary School

Total funding was approved for the washroom project at Ananda (Elementary school) during the presidency of Dr. Lasika Seneviratne and also approved by the BOD in July 2019. Col. Lucky Rajasinghe, Rakshita Dissanayake and Rahim Mantara were nominated to coordinate the project jointly with the 82 group of Ananda.

Commencement of the construction was delayed due to various administrative issues related to the construction site and COVID-19. BOD also prepared an MOU giving details of the areas of responsibilities for each group involved in the project. The amended project was approved by the EXCO and BOD in March 2021.

The construction of the project commenced in July,2021 and was completed by the end of October,2021. The building was ceremonially opened on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021(Founder's Day) by the college Principal in the presence of a restricted gathering of members of the 82 Group who worked very hard to accomplish the project.

A total amount of \$20459.64 was remitted to Sri Lanka through ACOBA-WC Acct in phases and the project is now complete.

Appreciate the continuous monitoring process of the Project Team led by Colonel Lucky Rajasinghe, Rakshita Dissanayake and Rahim Mantara throughout the project and the contribution made by Dr. Nalaka Gunawardena (CFO) in transferring the moneys in a timely manner.

## Founders' Day- Weekend of Mindfulness- October 30th and 31st

The event was jointly organized by the Anandians and Nalandians of the US West Coast. The virtual program was held on both days (Oct. 30<sup>th</sup>, and 31st) from 7.00 am to 11:30 am.
